MORE TIME TO VOTE



EARLY VOTING

2020 Presidential Primary

- Early Voting runs from April 18 to April 26.
- Election Day is April 28, 2020.

2020 State & Federal Primaries

- Early Voting runs from June 13 to June 21.
- Election Day is June 23, 2020.

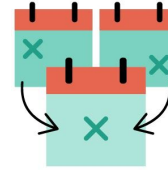
2020 General Election

- Early Voting runs from October 24 to Nov 1.
- Election Day is November 3, 2020.



UNIFORM POLLING HOURS STATEWIDE

All New Yorkers across the state will now be able to **vote from 6am to 9pm** in all elections.



CONSOLIDATED PRIMARIES

Instead of having separate primaries for federal, state and local elections, **primaries will be consolidated in June.** We still have a separate presidential primary in April.

MORE PEOPLE CAN VOTE



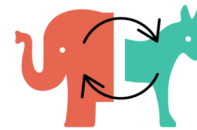
16 & 17-YEAR-OLDS CAN PRE-REGISTER TO VOTE

Teens **16 years or older** can now **pre-register to vote**, and the Board of Elections will automatically register those individuals once they turn 18.



PEOPLE ON PAROLE CAN GET RIGHTS RESTORED

It is now legal to **vote while on parole, with a pardon.** People on parole can get help getting their rights restored upon release, or by asking their parole officer.



PARTY AFFILIATION FLEXIBILITY

The deadline for voters to **change parties is now February 14 for all elections.** New voter registration is still 25 days before each election.

EASIER TO VOTE



VOTER REGISTRATION IS NOW PORTABLE

When New Yorkers move their voter registration automatically moves with them, if they **fill out a change of address with USPS.**



ELECTRONIC POLLBOOKS

Counties will now be able to use electronic poll books if they choose to.



VOTER FRIENDLY BALLOTS

Starting November 2020, new ballots will eliminate clutter, increase font size and emphasize the most important parts.
